## Mission and Aims

The Intelligent Transport Society for the United Kingdom (ITS (UK)) is a not-for-profit public/private sector association financed by members' subscriptions. It promotes the benefits of Intelligent Transport Solutions (ITS) and supports the interests of member organisations by:

- providing readily accessible opportunities for practitioners and stakeholders to meet on an equal footing to promote mutual understanding and to increase knowledge and awareness of ITS best practice;
- leading informed and balanced debate on ITS and influencing relevant policies by acting as the recognised reference point for information on ITS;
- engaging with, supporting and influencing policy and strategy at national, European and international levels; and
- promoting the international excellence of UK technology, expertise and solutions.

## Strategy

The mission and aims are achieved by:

1. drawing together active players and interested parties, by means of targeted Forums, Task Forces and other fora, to lead the debate about and knowledge of ITS deployment;
2. engaging with Government (Directorates, Agencies and Departments) nationally, regionally and locally and with Parliamentary bodies and members (including the Transport Select Committee) to influence policy and strategy for the UK
3. engaging with the European Commission, ERTICO, ITS America, ITS Asia Pacific and the large number of national ITS associations to influence ITS policy overseas;
4. educating and informing, in an accessible way, practitioners and stakeholders both within and beyond the current ITS community;
5. providing other membership benefits and services sufficient to attract and retain high membership uptake across all categories of ITS practitioners and stakeholders;
6. adopting and maintaining high national profile and influence and an international reputation through:
  - a high-profile President able and committed to promoting the mission;
  - a Chairman and Vice Chairman, committed to the ITS (UK) Mission and holding senior positions in the ITS sector;
  - the use of relevant people and media (including the press) to raise awareness, knowledge and debate about ITS issues of both strategic and topical relevance; and
  - promoting participation in targeted international activities;
7. developing, maintaining and promoting leading edge ITS seminars and documentation, demonstrating best practice, forethought and relevant case studies and indicating the economic, social and environmental contribution of ITS to transport policy; and
8. identifying, brokering and commissioning research unlikely otherwise to be commissioned on issues relevant to ITS deployment.

## MEMBERSHIP GRADES

### **Executive Membership**

This entitles all employees of the member company or organisation to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities.

**The Executive members form the Council of ITS United Kingdom, which determines the strategy and activities of the Society. The Chair and Vice Chair of ITS United Kingdom are elected by Council from its own ranks.**

Executive Members are highlighted by ITS (UK) whenever possible. They enjoy additional discounts at events and are given priority where places are restricted, such as trade missions and other Government events.

Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any number of locations.

Cost: £3,000.00 per year + VAT (Local Authorities, national Government Transport Departments and Universities £2,700.00 per year + VAT)

### **Corporate Membership**

This entitles all employees of the member company or organisation to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any reasonable number of locations.

Cost: £1,600.00 per year + VAT (Local Authorities and national Government Transport Departments £1,350.00 per year + VAT)

### **Corporate Membership: Small Enterprise**

This entitles a maximum of five employees of the member company or organisation to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any reasonable number of locations. Small Enterprise membership is restricted to organisations employing directly less than five full time staff or equivalent, and with a turnover as reported to Companies House of less than £400,000 per annum.

Cost: £900.00 per year + VAT

### **Corporate Membership: Micro Enterprise**

This entitles one single named self-employed/sole trader person to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities and receive information from ITS (UK).

Cost: £200.00 per year + VAT

### **Start-Up Membership**

This entitles all employees of the member entity to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any reasonable number of locations. Start-Up membership is restricted to organisations employing directly less than five full time staff or equivalent, and with a turnover of less than £400,000 per annum. It is also restricted to entities registered with Companies House or HMRC less than two years prior to applying to join ITS (UK). Start-up membership can be held for a maximum of two years.

Cost: £450.00 per year + VAT





### **University Membership**

This entitles all employees of a university to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any reasonable number of locations. Universities wishing to have a seat on the ITS (UK) Council should apply for Executive Membership.

Cost: £1,000.00 per year + VAT

### **Associate Membership**

This is open only to not-for-profit, non-Government, membership associations in the UK, and to any organisation without a UK base. It entitles all employees of the member organisation to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. Information can be sent to any reasonable number of staff at any reasonable number of locations.

Cost: £500.00 per year + VAT

### **Student Membership**

This is free to apprentices, undergraduates, masters students and those working towards a PhD, at Member Universities, and £10.00 + VAT for other apprentices/students. An academic tutor's or apprentice trainer's endorsement is required. NB apprentices at Member organisations are covered by that Membership by virtue of being employees.

### **Retired Membership**

This entitles a single retired person to participate in ITS United Kingdom events and activities. A declaration of deriving no income from ITS related work is required.

Cost: £100.00 per year + VAT
